

1. BRAND OVERVIEW



Dura Stat® products are smooth profiled with nonpyramid facades and generally are used for specific industry repair or maintenance tasks that doesn't require a traditional box crib stack to stabilize the machinery or equipment. Dura Stat® products are placed only in a single layer application when an object needs to be stabilized. Some of our popular Dura Stat® products are tire skates, the Turtle Trax® (US Patent D815,306) portable rail crossings, wedges and Rizers.



Dura Blend Lumber is engineered, smooth profile blocks that are the safer and cleaner alternative to wood timbers for indoor or outdoor storage of materials. Dura Blend Lumber comes in a variety of nominal sizes ranging in widths from 2" to 6" and lengths from 2' to 12'. Dura Blend Lumber doesn't absorb biohazards, can be cleaned easily, and will not rot or splinter. Not suitable for cribbing applications.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

Turtle Plastics® Dura Stat, and Dura Blend Lumber brand of products are made from recycled plastic in the USA. The products are used in a variety of industries including railroad, rescue, transportation and material handling for specific stabilization applications. For safety and warranty requirements, the products(s) should be used only by the end user/purchaser and should not be rented or leased to any third party.

NOTE: When applicable, product working load limits for Dura Stat® brand products are maximized in a 77-degree Fahrenheit (25-degree Celsius) environment; temperatures above or below will decrease working load limits. These products may have been sold under a different product name and/or part number. Please call Turtle Plastics® at 1-800-756-6635 or check with your distributor if you are unsure.

3. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Review, understand, and follow all safety instructions set forth in this document when using any of the products.
- Before using any of the products, familiarize yourself with applicable government regulations/ordinances/equipment owner's guides and your organization's policies and procedures for the use of the products and for any warnings or signage that may need to be posted while using these products.
- Before using these products understand the load rating and center of gravity of the equipment being stabilized.
- Make sure the environment in which the products will be used is safe.
- Inspect products for any damage prior to use; do not use if damaged.
- Replace products if worn or damaged.
- Make sure whatever is being stabilized using the products is not left unattended or for prolonged periods of time.
- Ensure products are clean and dry before use.
- Use mild soap and water or cleaning agents listed on the EPA List N to clean and disinfect products.
- Products are intended for temporary use.

4. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Use caution and conduct your own testing of your application of the Dura Stat® or Dura Blend Lumber products to ensure proper stabilization is conducted.
- Beware of any deflection, sagging or bending of the products during lifting or stabilization maneuvers.
- Dura Blend Lumber doesn't interlock and is not to be used in an active load cribbing application. Use Dura Crib® products instead.
- Dura Stat® is not used for any stacking configurations. Use Dura Crib® interlocking blocks and pads instead
- Do not use Dura Stat *or Dura Blend Lumber products in any crane equipment applications.
- All products are designed to be placed on a stable surface. Products are to be used on their horizontal façade (longest side) unless otherwise noted on the product.
- All products should have their product Turtle Plastics® Identification Label affixed to the product. Please call your distributor or Turtle Plastics® if you require a replacement identification tag.
- Ensure when using these products that whatever is being stabilized on the products, is placed in a uniformly distributed load manner and the majority of the load of the object or equipment lift isn't positioned in a manner onto a single point of contact (referred to as point source load).
- Use caution with wedges. While wedges are designed to fill gaps, they are not designed to carry load and should not be considered as part of the working load formula.
