1. BRAND OVERVIEW

The Cement Trowel Kit is part of the Dura Stat brand of products. Dura Stat products have a smooth profile with non-pyramid facades and generally are used for specific industry repair or maintenance tasks that don't require a traditional box crib stack to stabilize the machinery or equipment. Dura Stat products are placed only in a single layer application when an object needs to be stabilized. Some of our other popular Dura Stat products are tire skates, the Turtle Trax® (US Patent D815,306) portable rail crossings, wedges and rizers.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

The products are made from recycled plastic in the USA. For safety and warranty requirements, the products(s) should be used only on cement trowel equipment by the end user or purchaser and should not be rented or leased to any third party without prior written authorization of Turtle Plastics. Products are maximized in a 77-degree Fahrenheit (25-degree Celsius) environment; temperatures above or below will decrease performance or may deflect or break.

The cement trowel blocks have smooth facades with a uniquely designed cut out on one side of the block which is used to securely rest the last rung of the cement trowel machine. There are five (5) Cement Trowel Blocks in each kit. The kit is designed to use (4) four Cement Trowel Blocks during an application and (1) one extra Cement Trowel Block is provided as a spare. See diagram 1.

3. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS


- Review, understand, and follow all safety instructions set forth in this document when using the products.
- Before using any of the products, familiarize yourself with applicable government regulations/ordinances/equipment owner's guides and your organization's policies and procedures for the use of the products and for any warnings or signage that may need to be posted while using these products.
- Before using these products, understand the load rating and center of gravity of the cement trowel equipment.
- Make sure the environment in which the products will be used is safe.
- Use the Cement Trowel Block vertically.
- Inspect products for any damage prior to use; do not use them if damaged.
- Replace products if worn or damaged.
- Make sure cement trowel equipment when stabilized and using the products is not left unattended or for prolonged periods of time.
- Ensure products are clean and dry before use.
- Use mild soap and water or cleaning agents listed on EPA List N to clean and disinfect products.
- Products are intended for temporary use.

4. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Use caution and conduct your own testing of your cement trowel equipment to ensure proper performance of the products to your application.
- Beware of any deflection, sagging or bending of the products during use.
- Do not stack the Cement Trowel Blocks.
- The cement trowel blocks are designed to be placed on a stable surface.
- All products should have their manufacturer's labels on block intact. Please call Turtle Plastics if you need a replacement label.

6. PROPERTY DAMAGE AVOIDANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not overload products or exceed weight limits for the product.
- Unless stated in the equipment owner's guide, use (4) blocks when stabilizing the cement trowel equipment.
- Do not place weight unevenly onto product.
- The manufacturer's label on the product will indicate the direction of the block placement.
- Be sure only trained professionals use these products.
- Ensure you are inspecting products prior to use.
- Keep products in good working order and clean routinely with mild soap and water or agents listed in the EPA List N.
- Use the correct personal protective equipment when using the products.
